Airport pick-up

House Rules

- Students must be 18 + to choose this residence
- Mixed Gender: Male and female students share common areas and facilities, but bedrooms are single gender.
- Students need to sign a Tenancy Agreement. This should be sent out when booking the residence.
- A 100 euro deposit will be taken (paid by card) from the student upon arrival and return on their departure.
- Students are given a key on arrival; if you are in need of a replacement key, you will be charged 25 euro by card.
- No overnight guests
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the residence.
- HeyDay operates a 24-hour check-in, but students arriving in EC accommodation between 22:00 – 08:00 should notify the school about their arrival time so security is informed.
- While we promote and support diversity, we cannot guarantee language mix. However, we always encourage students to use English to communicate, be respectful and inclusive of others

Arrival and Departure

Arrival day: Saturday (Sunday arrival is possible)

Check-in: Guests can check in at 3pm

Students can leave their bags in the reception area and spend some time exploring Dublin city or relax in the Orla common area.

Students will check-in at the main reception area and be guided by Orla staff.

Reception is closed on Monday to Friday from 18:00 to 22:00. During these times students can call +353 1 454 8451 and they will be directed to Orla's out of hours Help Desk.

Cancellations

Cancellation prior to arrival

Students cancelling or postponing 14 days or less prior to their accommodation dates will be charged a two-week accommodation fee at the rate quoted in the price list for the accommodation booked and the accommodation placement fee.

Cancellation after arrival

Students leaving their accommodation must give notice in writing 4 weeks prior to termination. After deducting the price of accommodation used, including the required notice period, charged at standard accommodation rates, students will be refunded the remaining accommodation costs. If the 4-week notice period is not provided a cancellation fee equal to 4 weeks of the accommodation cost will apply.
