MyEC

What is MyEC?

MyEC is a personalised study tool and powerful learning companion throughout your EC journey. It also offers information about your EC centre, accommodation and about living in your chosen destination.

Your Online Placement Test

- To help us place you in the right level when you start studying with us, you must complete your Online Placement test before you arrive at school.
- If you do not complete this test before your first day, you may miss some of the first day activities and/or class time as this test must be completed before you start class.
- The Online Placement Test focuses on Reading, Writing and Use of English (Grammar and Vocabulary) and consists of 66 questions.
- Your speaking level will be assessed on your first day in school.

When can I access MyEC?

You will have access to MyEC as soon as you receive your booking confirmation. Start by logging in here: <https://signin.ecenglish.com/student>

What else must I do on MyEC before my arrival?

1. Access a bank of study materials to start learning before you even leave home.
2. Complete your Important Personal Details Form.
3. Complete your Needs Analysis Form.
4. Complete your placement test.
5. Fill in the pre-arrival survey.
6. Set your course objective on MyEC.

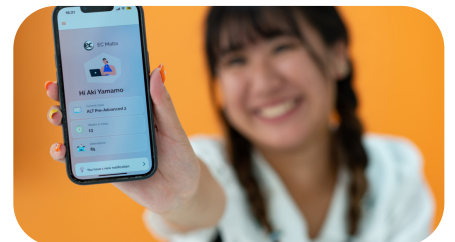

Arrival at Airport

What information do I need to give to book an airport transfer?

If you have booked accommodation with EC you must arrive at the airport between 08:00 and 20:00. Late/early arrivals may be asked to book alternative accommodation

Who will I meet at the airport?

Please provide your flight number, arrival time, terminal and airport of origin – minimum 2 week in advance.

What should I do if I cannot find the EC representative?

You will meet an EC transportation representative holding sign with the EC logo and your name. They will be waiting for you at Arrivals.

What should I do if I have missed my flight or my flight is delayed?

If after 10 minutes you cannot see your driver, please contact our emergency number +44 (0) 7983 773121 (Useful phrase to use: Hi, My name is (Maria Angeli). I am from (Italy). My student number is (123456). I am waiting (under the arrival sign).

What should I do if I haven't booked an EC transfer?

You should notify EC by calling +44 (0) 7983 773121 to rearrange your transfer time and avoid additional cost. Useful phrase to use: My name is (Maria Angeli). I am from (Italy). My student number is (123456) and my flight has been changed. My new flight number is (1234) arriving at (time).

What should I do if I haven't booked an EC transfer?

If you are travelling from Heathrow Airport to central London, The Heathrow Express <https://www.heathrowexpress.com> is the fastest way to travel. Trains from Heathrow leave every 15 minutes and the journey to London Paddington takes about 15-20 minutes. Trains to London leave Heathrow Airport from approximately 5am until 11.55pm.

The Piccadilly line connects Heathrow Airport to central London and the rest of the tube system. The Tube <https://tfl.gov.uk/plan-a-journey> is cheaper than the Heathrow Express or Heathrow Connect but it takes a lot longer. Tube services leave Heathrow every few minutes from approximately 5.10am (5.50am Sundays) to 11.45pm (11.30pm Sundays).

If you are travelling from Gatwick Airport, The Gatwick Express <https://www.gatwickexpress.com> is the fastest rail link between the airport and central London. Non-stop trains run to and from London Victoria every 15 minutes and take 30 minutes (35 minutes on Sundays). Please visit the websites for more information on prices.

What should I expect at my EC accommodation?

What should I do on the Sunday before school starts?

You will have the option of participating in activities arranged by EC. This is an opportunity to meet other new EC students, relax and be introduced to your new city together. With an EC staff member on hand, you can also ask any questions you may have. We will notify you of the Sunday welcome activity schedule the week before your arrival.

Public holidays

What happens on public holidays? Schools do not open on public holidays, so if Monday is a public holiday, your first day at the school will be on Tuesday.
